

## **MATERIALS SELECTION INQUIRY**

For this reason, we are providing a procedure for the public to air any criticism of library materials.

All concerns will be addressed by the Library Director.

If, following discussion with the Library Director, the user's concerns remain unresolved, the patron will be provided a Library Materials Complaint Form.

The Library Director will review the completed form and respond in writing. If the concerns are still not resolved, the matter may be presented to the Library Board of Trustees for its final review.
